File Description

File Name	File Description
iwarmonth/2010.xls or iwarmonth/2010.txt	The file contains all inactive wells carried on the Commission's proration schedule. The wells included in the file are those that are considered "inactive" under Oil & Gas Statewide Rule 14.

Additional Information

The month included in the file name is the current schedule month at the time the file was generated. For example:

Data Dictionary

The data dictionary provides the description of the data fields in the files.

1	Operator Number	RRC assigned number for Operator of record.
2	Operator Name	Name of Operator of record
3	API County Number	Code for the county in which the well is located.
4	API Unique Number	Unique number assigned to identify the wellbore.
5	County Name	County in which the well is located
6	Oil & Gas Code	Code designating if the well is oil, gas, or both.
7	District Code	RRC District number
8	Lease Number	Numeric designation for the lease assigned by the RRC.
9	Well Number	Numeric or alphanumeric designation for the well assigned by the RRC.
10	Oil Unit Number	This item contains the unit number of a multi-well group (unit) for wells in the Yates field.
11	Lease Name	Lease on which the well is located
12	Field Number	Numeric designation for field assigned by the RRC.

Data Field No.	Data Field Name	Data Field Description
18	Field Name	Field in which the well is located.
14	Water/Land Code	Code designating if the well is on land or in water.
15	API Depth	The depth of the wellbore.
16	Shut-in Date	The year and month the well was shut-in.
17	P5 Renewal Month	The month in which the P5 is up for renewal.
18	P5 Renewal Year	The year in which the P5 is up for renewal.
19	P5 Organization Status	The status of the P5 organization.
20	Current 5 Yr Inactive	Yes or No – This flag indicates if the well is inactive for 5 years as of the current schedule.
21	Aged 5 Yr Inactive	Yes or No – This flag indicates if the well is inactive for 5 years as of the P5 renewal date.
22	Current 10 Yr Inactive	Yes or No – This flag indicates if the well is inactive for 10 years as of the current schedule month.
23	Aged 10 Yr Inactive	Yes or No – This flag indicates if the well is inactive for 10 years as of the P5 renewal date.
24	Current Inactive Years	This indicates the number of years the well has been inactive as of the current schedule month.
25	Current Inactive Months	This indicates the number of months the well has been inactive as of the current schedule month.
26	Aged Inactive Years	This indicates the number of years the well has been inactive as of the P5 renewal date.
27	Aged Inactive Months	This indicates the number of months the well has been inactive as of the P5 renewal date.
28	Extension Status	This indicates the current status of the plugging extension for the current P-5 year.

Data Field No.	Data Field Name	Data Field Description
30	Cost Calculations	<p>This indicates the depth of the well multiplied by the average per-foot plugging costs for the District the well is located in for Commission-plugged wells during the most recently completed fiscal year.</p> <p>When only one Operator name is used in the search, the total Cost Calculation for the selected operator is included in the header information. This excludes wells with a Compliance Due Date after the P5 Renewal Date.</p>
32	Wells Plugged	Indicates that the District Office has shown receipt of a plugging report (Form W-3) for the indicated well, but that the well has not yet been removed from the schedule.
33	Compliance Date	This pertains only to 142 Inactive Wells that have been transferred/sold to the Operator since September 13th 2010. Per Statewide Rule 15, the operator has six months from the date of P-4 approval to bring the well into compliance (by plugging, restoring to active operation, or securing a plugging extension). Such wells cannot be transferred to another party until they have been brought into compliance.
34	Original Completion Date	This date reflects the oldest well record date on file according to Commission records.
