**NOTICE TO NATURAL GAS PRODUCERS, GAS FACILITY
OPERATORS AND GAS PIPELINE FACILITY OPERATORS**

Best Practices in Response to Winter Weather Forecasted This Week

The National Weather Service has indicated certain areas in the state will experience overnight temperatures dropping below freezing this week and early next week, followed by warmups during the daytime.

The Railroad Commission of Texas (RRC) asks operators to monitor and maintain operations for potential impacts, as safety permits.

For guidance, the RRC has previously issued notices with best practices that can be utilized to protect against freezing conditions.
