**FINAL ORDER
CONSOLIDATING THE FARRAR (COTTON VALLEY SAND) FIELD
INTO THE FARRAR (COTTON VALLEY LIME) FIELD
AND AMENDING FIELD RULES
ADOPTED IN FINAL ORDER NO. 5-72,327
EFFECTIVE MAY 7, 1979, AS AMENDED,
FOR THE FARRAR (COTTON VALLEY LIME) FIELD
FREESTONE AND LIMESTONE COUNTIES, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on August 20, 2001, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the Farrar (Cotton Valley Sand) Field, located in Freestone and Limestone Counties, Texas, be and it is hereby consolidated into the Farrar (Cotton Valley Lime) Field.

It is further **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that Rule 1 adopted in Final Order No. 5-72,327, issued effective May 7, 1979, as amended, for the Farrar (Cotton Valley Lime) Field, Freestone and Limestone Counties, Texas, be amended as follows:

RULE 1: The entire correlative interval from the top of the Cotton Valley Sand at 10,200 feet to the base of the underlying Cotton Valley Lime at 13,488 feet as shown on the log of the Herd Producing Company Standley Well No. 2 (now the XTO Energy Darrell Standley GU 2 Lease, Well No. 2), Manuel C. Rejon Survey, Limestone County, Texas, shall be designated as a single reservoir for proration purposes and be designated as the Farrar (Cotton Valley Lime) Field.

It is further **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the field rules, adopted in Final Order No. 5-72,480, issued effective May 21, 1979, as amended, for the Farrar (Cotton Valley Sand) Field be and they are rescinded.

It is further **ORDERED** by the Commission that the following wells be and are hereby transferred from the Farrar (Cotton Valley Sand) Field to the Farrar (Cotton Valley Lime) Field:
